Financial innovation and market dynamics: the role of securities regulation

CONSOB and Bocconi University, through its CAREFIN and “Paolo Baffi” research centers, are organizing a conference on financial innovation, capital markets dynamics and the implications for securities regulation.

The conference will focus on the following issues:

- financial innovation and systemic risks for securities markets;
- market microstructure and trading strategies;
- new financial products and households portfolio choices;
- financial education and suitability of financial products for retail investors;
- implications of financial innovation for regulation and supervision of securities markets.

Papers on other issues relevant for securities markets regulation, such as corporate governance and corporate finance, may be taken into account as well.

Interested authors should submit their paper to the e-mail studi_analisi@consob.it by October 14, 2011. Papers may be submitted in a preliminary version, provided that the aim of the research, the methodological approach and the main results are clearly outlined.
